Ready to Join the Cast?

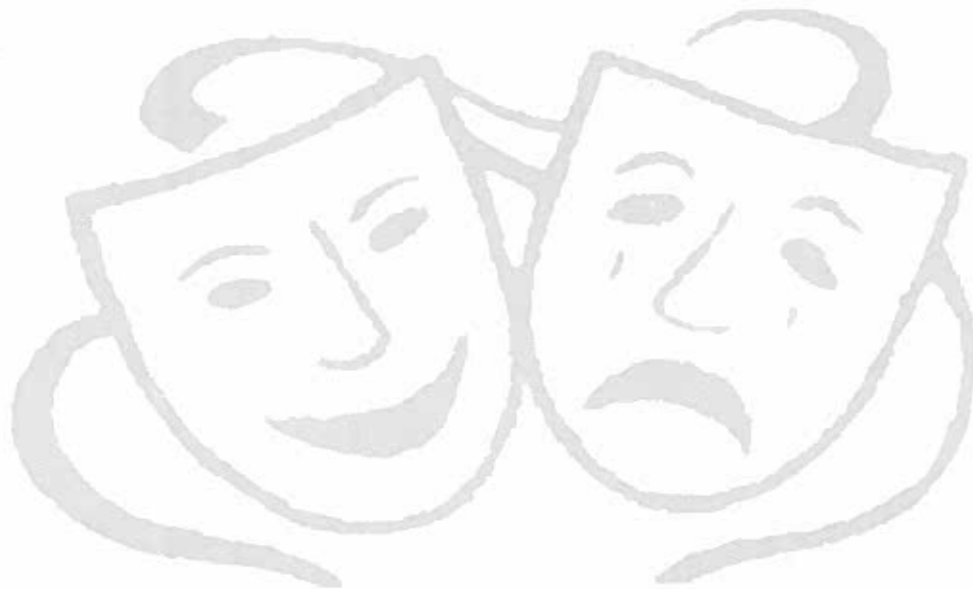
